Senior Swim Program: Monday, Wednesday & Friday 10:00 – 11:30 AM
Fee: \$1.00 per swim

Lap Swim Program: Tuesday & Thursday 7:00 – 9:00 PM
Fee: \$3.50 per swim or \$55.00 for a 20 visit pass

This program offers lap swim and therapy pool hours to all. Lap Swimmers must be 14 years of age or older.

Sharks Swim Team Program: Monday, Wednesday & Friday
Blue Team Practice 4:30 – 5:45 PM
Gold Team Practice 5:45 – 7:15 PM
Fee: \$35.00 a month per swimmer
