## **ANNUAL PANCAKE BREAKFAST**

EL MONTE, Calif. – The City of El Monte, in conjunction with the Los Angeles County Fire and the El Monte Police Departments, will be hosting a benefit Pancake Breakfast and Open House at El Monte Fire Station 166 on Saturday, May 24, 2003 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. through 1:00 p.m. Proceeds from the program will benefit the Los Angeles County Fire Explorer Post #10 and the El Monte Police Explorer Post 522. Breakfast tickets are \$4.00, and can be purchased from any El Monte Fire Station; the City of El Monte City Manager's Office; or on-site the day of the event. Serving time will be 8:30-11:30 a.m. The open house will remain open until 1:00 p.m.

County Fire demonstrations will include proper fire extinguisher use, high angle rappelling off the Training Tower, Jaws of Life deployment, vehicle lift bags and other firefighting and life saving equipment. Activities will include a Bounce House for the kids and an obstacle course for older youth. Residents and businesses and families are encouraged to attend this worthwhile event. Bring your camera and take pictures of your kids on the firefighting apparatus.

Fire Station 166 is located on Santa Anita just south of the El Monte Valley Mall. Parking is easily available either at Pioneer Park (south of the Fire Station), or across the street in the El Monte mall parking lot. Parking is free.
