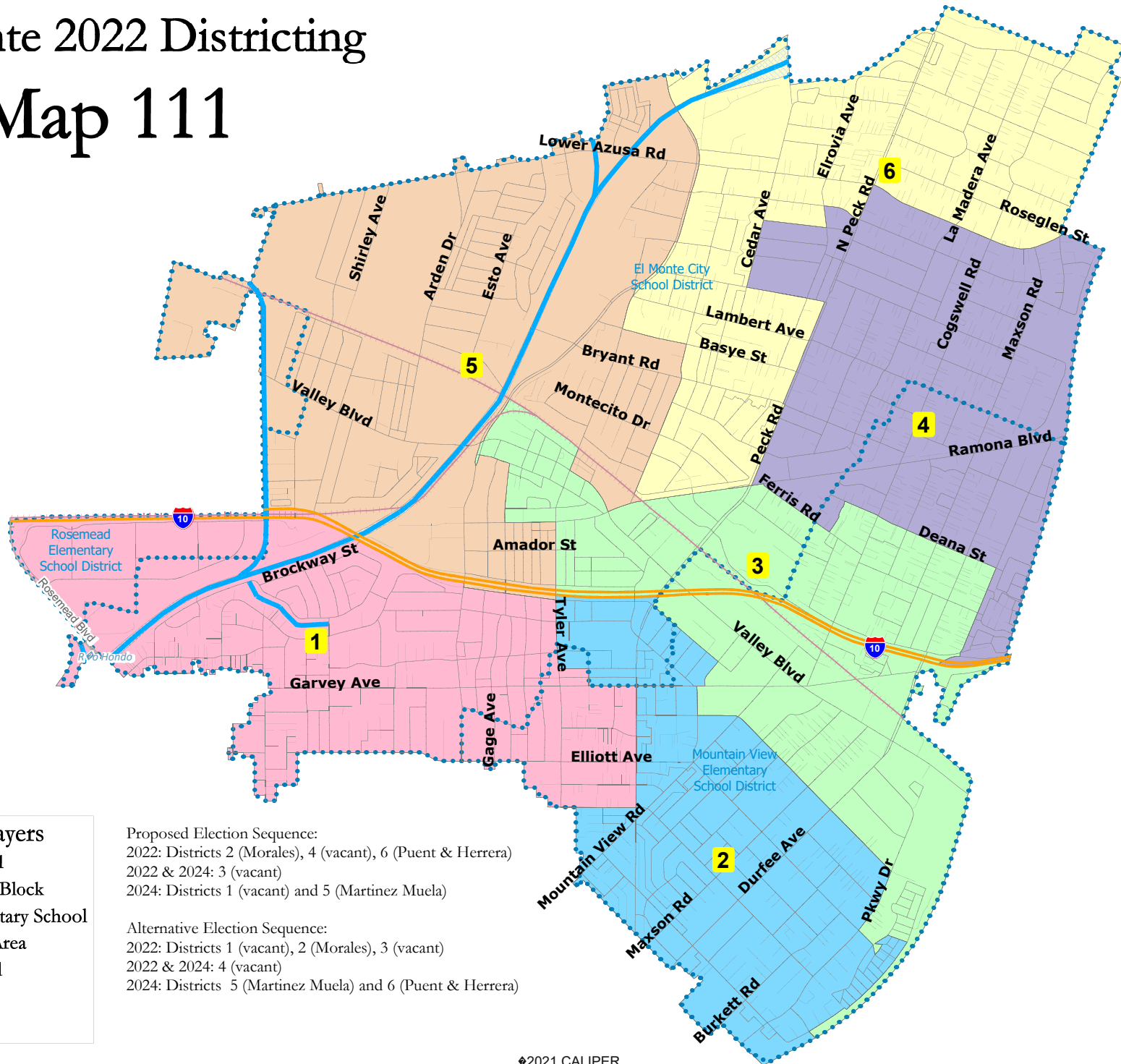


# El Monte 2022 Districting
